Amends the Fish and Aquatic Life Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the unlawful release or introduction of aquatic life.

1 AN ACT concerning fish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fish and Aquatic Life Code is amended by changing Section 10-100 as follows:
- 6 (515 ILCS 5/10-100) (from Ch. 56, par. 10-100)
- 7 Sec. 10-100. Release of aquatic life.
- 8 (a) It shall be unlawful to release any aquatic life into
 9 the the wild in this State without first securing permission of
 10 the Department to do so, except that the owner of a body of
 11 water may release aquatic life indigenous to the State of
- 12 Illinois into waters wholly upon his or her property. The
- 13 Department shall have the authority to promulgate necessary
- 14 rules and regulations, under the Illinois Administrative
- 15 Procedure Act, regulating the possession, transportation, and
- 16 shipping of aquatic life not indigenous to the State of
- 17 Illinois. All aquatic life may be immediately returned unharmed
- 18 from where they were taken.
- 19 (b) It is unlawful to possess, transport, or release any
- 20 live specimen or viable gametes of any species listed as
- 21 injurious by administrative rule, unless authorized by that
- 22 rule. A violation of this subsection (b) is a Class A
- 23 misdemeanor.
