1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1155

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1155, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 27, on page 24, by replacing lines 2 through 26 with the  
5 following:

6 "is a Class A misdemeanor. A second violation of subsection  
7 (a), (b), (c), (d), or (f) is a Class A misdemeanor for which  
8 the licensee shall not be eligible for supervision, and the  
9 licensee's license to carry a handgun shall be suspended for a  
10 period of not less than 6 months, and the licensee shall be  
11 required to complete a training course in accordance with  
12 subsection (a) of Section 250-85 of this Act prior to  
13 reinstatement of the license to carry a handgun. A third  
14 violation of subsection (a), (b), (c), (d), or (f) is a Class 4  
15 felony.

16 (i) A violation of subsection (e) is a Class A misdemeanor  
17 for which the licensee shall not be eligible for supervision,  
18 and the licensee's license to carry a handgun shall be

1 suspended for a period of not less than 6 months. A second  
2 violation of subsection (e) is a Class A misdemeanor for which  
3 the licensee shall not be eligible for supervision, and the  
4 licensee's license to carry a handgun shall be suspended for a  
5 period of not less than one year, and the licensee shall be  
6 required to complete a training course in accordance with  
7 subsection (a) of Section 250-85 of this Act prior to  
8 reinstatement of the license to carry a handgun. A third  
9 violation of subsection (e) is a Class 3 felony. A licensee  
10 with 3 or more violations of subsection (e)"; and

11 on page 42 , by replacing lines 12 and 13 with the following:

12 "(c) This Section does not apply to a person granted a  
13 license to carry a handgun under the Family and Personal  
14 Protection Act."; and

15 on page 44, by replacing lines 5 through 8 with the following:

16 "person who has been issued a currently valid Firearm Owner's  
17 Identification Card, or, if the weapon is a handgun, a  
18 currently valid license to carry a handgun issued in accordance  
19 with the Family and Personal Protection Act. For purposes of  
20 this subsection, "handgun" has the same meaning ascribed to it  
21 in Section 250-10 of the Family and Personal Protection Act;  
22 or"; and

23 on page 45, by replacing lines 24 and 25 with the following:

1 "engaged in firearm safety training courses; or"; and

2 on page 46, by replacing lines 20 through 23 with the  
3 following:

4 "person who has been issued a currently valid Firearm Owner's  
5 Identification Card, or, if the weapon is a handgun, a  
6 currently valid license to carry a handgun issued in accordance  
7 with the Family and Personal Protection Act. For purposes of  
8 this subsection, "handgun" has the same meaning ascribed to it  
9 in Section 250-10 of the Family and Personal Protection Act.";

10 and

11 on page 48, by replacing lines 6 through 10 with the following:

12 "Class A misdemeanor. A person convicted of a"; and

13 on page 55, by replacing lines 18 through 22 with the  
14 following:

15 "carrying box, shipping box, or other container by a person who  
16 has been issued a currently valid Firearm Owner's  
17 Identification Card, or, if the weapon is a handgun, a  
18 currently valid license to carry a handgun issued in accordance  
19 with the Family and Personal Protection Act. For purposes of  
20 this subsection, "handgun" has the same meaning ascribed to it  
21 in Section 250-10 of the Family and Personal Protection Act.".
