- Section 5. The Roadside Memorial Act is amended by adding

  Section 23.1 as follows:

- 8 Sec. 23.1. Fatal accident memorial marker program.
- 9 (a) The fatal accident memorial marker program is intended
  10 to raise public awareness of reckless driving by emphasizing
  11 the dangers while affording families an opportunity to remember
- the victims of crashes involving reckless drivers.
- 13 (b) As used in this Section, "fatal accident memorial

  14 marker" means a marker on a highway in this State commemorating
- one or more persons who died as a proximate result of a crash
- 16 <u>caused by a driver who committed an act of reckless homicide in</u>
- violation of Section 9-3 or 9-3.2 of the Criminal Code of 1961

or the Criminal Code of 2012 or who otherwise caused the death

- of one or more persons through the operation of a motor

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- 21 (c) For purposes of the fatal accident memorial marker
- 22 program in this Section, the provisions of Section 15 of this
- 23 Act applicable to DUI memorial markers shall apply the same to

- 2 (d) A fatal accident memorial marker shall consist of a
- 3 white on blue panel bearing the message "Reckless Driving Costs
- 4 Lives". At the request of the qualified relative, a separate
