1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1530 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1530 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 4 5 changing Section 3-698 as follows: 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-698) 7 Sec. 3-698. U.S. Air Force License Plates. (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 8 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of 9 10 State, may issue special registration plates designated as U.S. 11 Air Force license plates to residents of Illinois who meet 12 eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. 13 Upon the death of a person that has been issued U.S. Air Force

license plates under this Section, that person's surviving

spouse shall be entitled to retain the plates so long as the

surviving spouse is a resident of Illinois and transfers the

- registration to his or her name within 90 days of their spouse's death. The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
  - (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except that the U.S. Air Force emblem shall appear on the plates. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.
  - (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be deposited into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this

- additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of 1
- 2 State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited
- 3 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund.
- 4 (d) The Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund is created
- 5 as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the
- 6 Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund shall be paid, subject
- 7 to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the
- Secretary, as grants to the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage 8
- 9 Foundation of Illinois for operational and program expenses of
- 10 the Chanute Air Museum.
