AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Downstate Forest Preserve District Act is 5 amended by changing Section 3c as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 805/3c)

7 Sec. 3c. Elected board of commissioners in certain counties. If the boundaries of a district are co-extensive with 8 9 the boundaries of a county having a population of more than 800,000 but less than 3,000,000, all commissioners of the 10 forest preserve district shall be elected from the same 11 districts as members of the county board beginning with the 12 general election held in 2002 and each succeeding general 13 14 election. One commissioner shall be elected from each district. At their first meeting after their election in 2002 and 15 16 following each subsequent decennial reapportionment of the 17 county under Division 2-3 of the Counties Code, the elected commissioners shall publicly by lot divide themselves into 2 18 19 groups, as equal in size as possible. Commissioners from the first group shall serve for terms of 2, 4, and 4 years; and 20 21 commissioners from the second group shall serve terms of 4, 4, 22 and 2 years. Beginning with the general election in 2002, the president of the board of commissioners of the forest preserve 23

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district shall be elected by the voters of the county, rather 1 2 than by the commissioners. The president shall be a resident of 3 the county and shall be elected throughout the county for a 4-year term without having been first elected as commissioner 4 5 of the forest preserve district. Each commissioner shall be a resident of the county board district from which he or she was 6 7 elected not later than the date of the commencement of the term The term of office for the president 8 office. of and 9 commissioners elected under this Section shall commence on the 10 first Monday of the month following the month of election. 11 Neither a commissioner nor the president of the board of 12 commissioners of that forest preserve district shall serve simultaneously as member or chairman of the county board. No 13 14 person shall seek election to both the forest preserve 15 commission and the county board at the same election. The 16 president, with the advice and consent of the board of 17 commissioners shall appoint a secretary, treasurer, and such necessary by the board 18 other officers as deemed of commissioners, which officers need not be members of the board 19 of commissioners. The president shall have the powers and 20 duties as specified in Section 12 of this Act. 21

22 Candidates for president and commissioner shall be 23 candidates of established political parties.

1 commissioners shall declare that а vacancy exists and 2 notification of the vacancy shall be given to the county central committee of each established political party within 3 3 business days after the occurrence of the vacancy. If the 4 5 vacancy occurs in the office of forest preserve district commissioner, the president of the board of commissioners 6 7 shall, within 60 days after the date of the vacancy, with the 8 advice and consent of other commissioners then serving, appoint 9 a person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. The appointee shall be affiliated with the same political party as 10 11 the commissioner in whose office the vacancy occurred and be a 12 resident of such district. If a vacancy in the office of president occurs, other than by expiration of the president's 13 14 term, the remaining members of the board of commissioners shall, within 60 days after the vacancy, appoint one of the 15 16 commissioners to serve as president for the remainder of the 17 unexpired term. In that case, the office of the commissioner who is appointed to serve as president shall be deemed vacant 18 19 and shall be filled within 60 days by appointment of the 20 president with the advice and consent of the other forest preserve district commissioners. The commissioner who is 21 22 appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of president shall be 23 affiliated with the same political party as the person who occupied the office of president prior to the vacancy. A person 24 25 appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of president or 26 commissioner shall establish his or her party affiliation by

his or her record of voting in primary elections or by holding 1 2 or having held an office in an established political party 3 organization before the appointment. If the appointee has not voted in a party primary election or is not holding or has not 4 5 held an office in an established political party organization before the appointment, the appointee shall establish his or 6 7 her political party affiliation by his or her record of 8 participating in an established political party's nomination 9 or election caucus. If, however, more than 28 months remain in 10 the unexpired term of a commissioner or the president, the 11 appointment shall be until the next general election, at which 12 time the vacated office of commissioner or president shall be 13 election for the remainder of filled by the term. 14 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if a vacancy occurs 15 after the last day provided in Section 7-12 of the Election 16 Code for filing nomination papers for the office of president 17 of a forest preserve district where that office is elected as provided for in this Section, or as set forth in Section 7-61 18 19 of the Election Code, a vacancy in nomination shall be filled 20 by the passage of a resolution by the nominating committee of 21 the affected political party within the time periods specified 22 in the Election Code. The nominating committee shall consist of 23 the chairman of the county central committee and the township chairmen of the affected political party. All other vacancies 24 25 in nomination shall be filled in accordance with the provisions 26 of the Election Code.

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1 The president and commissioners elected under this Section 2 may be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses actually 3 incurred in performing their official duties under this Act in 4 accordance with the provisions of Section 3a. The reimbursement 5 paid under this Section shall be paid by the forest preserve 6 district.

Compensation for the president and the forest preserve
commissioners elected under this Section shall be established
by the board of commissioners of the forest preserve district.

10 <u>At the next general election after the effective date of</u> 11 <u>this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, the question</u> 12 <u>of whether the president and forest preserve district</u> 13 <u>commissioners shall serve without compensation shall be</u> 14 <u>presented to the voters of the county in which a forest</u> 15 <u>preserve district described under this Section is located.</u>

16 <u>The proposition shall be in substantially the following</u> 17 <u>form:</u>

18Shall the president and forest preserve district19commissioners of (name of forest preserve district) serve20without compensation, except that they shall be reimbursed21for their reasonable expenses?

22 The votes shall be recorded as "Yes" and "No".

If a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the proposition, the president and forest preserve commissioners whose terms begin on and after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly shall serve without HB2377 Engrossed - 6 - LRB098 04018 OMW 34038 b

1 compensation, except that they shall be reimbursed for their
2 reasonable expenses actually incurred in performing their
3 official duties under this Act in accordance with the
4 provisions of Section 3a. The reimbursement paid under this
5 Section shall be paid by the forest preserve district.
