AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by changing
Section 6-906 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 5/6-906) (from Ch. 121, par. 6-906)

7 Sec. 6-906. So much of the amount apportioned to a county under Section 6-901 that is obligated under Sections 6-902 8 9 through 6-904 and for which local funds have been committed under Section 6-905, within two years from the date the 10 apportionment is made, shall, upon certification by the 11 Department, be paid to the county treasurer, who shall apply 12 those funds to the payment of such obligations. Any funds 13 14 allocated to a county under Section 6-901 that are not obligated within 48 24 months under Sections 6-902 through 15 16 6-904 shall revert to the Road Fund.
