AN ACT concerning transportation. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly:

- 7 Sec. 6-906. So much of the amount apportioned to a county
- under Section 6-901 that is obligated under Sections 6-902 8

- 10 under Section 6-905, within 4 \pm wo years from the date the
- apportionment is made, shall, upon certification by the 11
- Department, be paid to the county treasurer, who shall apply 12
- those funds to the payment of such obligations. Any funds 13
- 14 allocated to a county under Section 6-901 that are not
- obligated within 48 24 months under Sections 6-902 through 15
- 16 6-904 shall revert to the Road Fund.
