SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 105/27.3d

Amends the Clerks of Courts Act. Provides that unless an amount or percentage is otherwise provided by statute, for fines, fees, and costs collected and disbursed by the Circuit Court Clerk pursuant to statute, the county board may require the Circuit Court Clerk in its county to retain not less than 1% nor more than 5% for deposit in the Circuit Court Clerk Operation and Administrative Fund. Provides that for funds held in trust by the Circuit Court Clerk pursuant to statute or court order, except for bail bond or child support payment amounts, the county board may require the Circuit Court Clerk in its county to retain not less than 1% nor more than 5% for deposit in the Circuit Court Clerk Operation and Administrative Fund.

1 AN ACT concerning courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Clerks of Courts Act is amended by changing Section 27.3d as follows:

- 7 Sec. 27.3d. Circuit Court Clerk Operation and 8 Administrative Fund.
- 9 (a) Each Circuit Court Clerk shall create a Circuit Court Clerk Operation and Administrative Fund, to be used to offset 10 the costs incurred by the Circuit Court Clerk in performing the 11 additional duties required to collect and disburse funds to 12 entities of State and local government as provided by law. The 13 14 Circuit Court Clerk shall be the custodian, ex officio, of this Fund and shall use the Fund to perform the duties required by 15 16 the office. The Fund shall be audited by the auditor retained 17 by the Clerk for the purpose of conducting the Annual Circuit Court Clerk Audit. Expenditures shall be made from the Fund by 18 19 the Circuit Court Clerk for expenses related to the cost of collection for and disbursement to entities of State and local 20 21 government.
 - (b) Unless an amount or percentage is otherwise provided by statute, for fines, fees, and costs collected and disbursed by

- 1 the Circuit Court Clerk pursuant to statute, the county board

- 9 <u>Clerk Operation and Administrative Fund. This subsection does</u>
- 10 not include bail bond or child support payment amounts.
