2 Section 45. The sum of \$939,800, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers' 4 Assistance Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers' 5 assistance programs.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 7 2013.
