A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
6 Supreme Court to pay the ordinary and contingent expenses of  
7 certain officers of the court system of Illinois as follows:

8 For Personal Services:

9 Judges' Salaries .....\$185,844,000

10 For Travel:

11 Judicial Officers .....1,048,500

12 For State Contributions

13 to Social Security .....2,694,700

15 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof

11 Section 30. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 13 Fund to the Supreme Court for deposit into the Foreign  
 14 Language Interpreter Fund for the operation of the Foreign  
 15 Language Interpreter Program.

16 Section 35. The sum of \$26,515,000, or so much thereof  
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory  
 18 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory  
 19 Arbitration Programs.

20 Section 40. The sum of \$1,145,100, or so much thereof as  
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language  
 22 Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign

1 Language Interpreter Program.

2 Section 45. The sum of \$939,800, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers'  
4 Assistance Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers'  
5 assistance programs.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
7 2013.
