Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that a person 14 and under may use a crossbow. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section
 2.5 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.5)

Sec. 2.5. Crossbow conditions. A person may use a crossbow
if one or more of the following conditions are met:

(1) the user is a person age 62 and older;

10 (2) the user is a handicapped person to whom the 11 Director has issued a permit to use a crossbow, as provided 12 by administrative rule; or

13 (3) the date of using the crossbow is during the period 14 of the second Monday following the Thanksgiving holiday 15 through the last day of the archery deer hunting season 16 (both inclusive) set annually by the Director; or -

(4) the user is a person age 14 and under.

As used in this Section, "handicapped person" means a person who has a physical impairment due to injury or disease, congenital or acquired, which renders them so severely disabled as to be unable to use a longbow, recurve bow, or compound bow. Permits must be issued only after the receipt of a physician's statement confirming the applicant is handicapped as defined HB2703
