1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2754

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2754 as follows:

3 on page 1, line 5, by replacing "Section 5.826" with "Sections
4 5.826 and 5.827"; and

5 on page 1, below line 7, by inserting the following:

6 "(30 ILCS 105/5.827 new)

7 Sec. 5.827. The Curing Childhood Cancer Fund."; and

8 on page 1, line 9, by replacing "Section 3-699" with "Sections
9 3-699 and 3-699.1"; and

10 on page 3, below line 6, by inserting the following:

11 "(625 ILCS 5/3-699.1 new)

12 Sec. 3-699.1. Curing Childhood Cancer Plates.

1 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
2 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
3 issue special registration plates designated as Curing
4 Childhood Cancer license plates. The special plates issued
5 under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles
6 of the first division or motor vehicles of the second division
7 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this
8 Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure
9 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

10 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be
11 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate
12 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany
13 each application.

14 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a
15 \$65 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate
16 registration fee. Of this fee, \$50 shall be deposited into the
17 Curing Childhood Cancer Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into
18 the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used
19 by the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing
20 costs. For each registration renewal period, a \$52 fee, in
21 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.
22 Of this fee, \$50 shall be deposited into the Curing Childhood
23 Cancer Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of
24 State Special License Plate Fund.

25 (d) The Curing Childhood Cancer Fund is created as a
26 special fund in the State treasury. All money in the Curing

1 Childhood Cancer Fund shall be paid, subject to appropriation
2 by the General Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, in
3 equal share as grants to the St. Jude Children's Research
4 Hospital and the Children's Oncology Group for the purpose of
5 funding scientific research on cancer."
