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1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2947
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 2947 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The State Budget Law of the Civil
5	Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section
6	50-10 as follows:
7	(15 ILCS 20/50-10) (was 15 ILCS 20/38.1)
8	Sec. 50-10. Budget contents. The budget shall be submitted
9	by the Governor with line item and program data. The budget
10	shall also contain performance data presenting an estimate for
11	the current fiscal year, projections for the budget year, and
12	information for the 3 prior fiscal years comparing department
13	objectives with actual accomplishments, formulated according
14	to the various functions and activities, and, wherever the
15	nature of the work admits, according to the work units, for
16	which the respective departments, offices, and institutions of

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the State government (including the elective officers in the executive department and including the University of Illinois and the judicial department) are responsible.

For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1992 and for each fiscal year thereafter, the budget shall include the performance measures of each department's accountability report.

8 For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1997 and for each 9 fiscal year thereafter, the budget shall include one or more 10 line items appropriating moneys to the Department of Human 11 Services to fund participation in the Home-Based Support 12 Services Program for Mentally Disabled Adults under the 13 Developmental Disability and Mental Disability Services Act by 14 persons described in Section 2-17 of that Act.

15 The budget shall contain a capital development section in 16 which the Governor will present (1) information on the capital projects and capital programs for which appropriations are 17 requested, (2) the capital spending plans, which shall document 18 19 the first and subsequent years cash requirements by fund for 20 the proposed bonded program, and (3) a statement that shall 21 identify by year the principal and interest costs until 22 retirement of the State's general obligation debt. In addition, 23 the principal and interest costs of the budget year program 24 shall be presented separately, to indicate the marginal cost of 25 principal and interest payments necessary to retire the 26 additional bonds needed to finance the budget year's capital 09800HB2947ham001

program. In 2004 only, the capital development section of the State budget shall be submitted by the Governor not later than the fourth Tuesday of March (March 23, 2004).

4 The budget shall contain a Section indicating whether there 5 is a projected budget surplus or a projected budget deficit for the current fiscal year, or whether the current fiscal year's 6 budget is projected to be balanced, based on estimates prepared 7 by the Governor's Office of Management and Budget using actual 8 9 figures available on the date the budget is submitted. These 10 estimates shall not include as assets any monies borrowed or 11 swept during the current fiscal year from funds other than budgeted funds as that term is defined in subsection (a) of 12 13 Section 50-5. These estimates shall include all liabilities 14 actually incurred during the current fiscal year regardless of 15 whether the liability is to be paid out of a future fiscal year's appropriation. These estimates shall not include 16 payments that are made from a future fiscal year's 17 appropriations, as provided in Section 25 of the State Finance 18 19 Act.

For the budget year, the current year, and 3 prior fiscal years, the Governor shall also include in the budget estimates of or actual values for the assets and liabilities for General Assembly Retirement System, State Employees' Retirement System of Illinois, State Universities Retirement System, Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois, and Judges Retirement System of Illinois. 09800HB2947ham001 -4- LRB098 10773 JDS 42625 a

1 The budget submitted by the Governor shall contain, in 2 addition, in a separate book, a tabulation of all position and employment titles in each such department, office, 3 and institution, the number of each, and the salaries for each, 4 5 formulated according to divisions, bureaus, sections, offices, 6 departments, boards, and similar subdivisions, which shall correspond as nearly as practicable to the functions and 7 activities for which the department, office, or institution is 8 9 responsible.

10 Together with the budget, the Governor shall transmit the 11 estimates of receipts and expenditures, as received by the 12 Director of the Governor's Office of Management and Budget, of 13 the elective officers in the executive and judicial departments 14 and of the University of Illinois.

15 An applicable appropriations committee of each chamber of 16 the General Assembly, for fiscal year 2012 and thereafter, must 17 review individual line item appropriations and the total budget 18 for each State agency, as defined in the Illinois State 19 Auditing Act.
