SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 3983/20

Amends the Illinois Latino Family Commission Act. Requires the State Board of Education, the State Board of Higher Education, the Illinois Community College Board, the Department of Human Rights, and the Capital Development Board to provide a liaison to serve ex-officio on the Illinois Latino Family Commission. Deletes a provision requiring the Department of Public Aid to provide a liaison to serve ex-officio on the Commission.

AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Latino Family Commission Act is 5 amended by changing Section 20 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 3983/20)

7 Sec. 20. Appointment; terms. The Illinois Latino Family 8 Commission shall be comprised of 15 members. The Governor, the 9 President of the Senate, the Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Minority 10 Leader of the House of Representatives shall each appoint 3 11 members to the Commission. Each member shall have working 12 knowledge of human services, community development, and 13 14 economic public policies in Illinois. The Governor shall appoint the chairperson or chairpersons. 15

16 The members shall reflect regional representation to 17 ensure that the needs of Latino families and children 18 throughout the State are met. The members shall be selected 19 from a variety of disciplines. They shall represent a 20 partnership and collaborative effort between public and 21 private agencies, the business sector, and community-based 22 human services organizations.

Members shall serve 3-year terms, except in the case of

initial appointments. Five members, as determined by lot, shall be appointed to one-year terms; 5 members shall be appointed to 2-year terms; and 5 members shall be appointed to 3-year terms, so that the terms are staggered. Members shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for Commission-related expenses.

The Department on Aging, the Department of Children and 7 8 Family Services, the Department of Commerce and Economic 9 Opportunity, the Department of Corrections, the Department of 10 Employment Security, the Department of Human Services, the 11 Department of Public Aid, the Department of Public Health, and 12 the Department of Transportation, the State Board of Education, 13 the State Board of Higher Education, the Illinois Community College Board, the Department of Human Rights, and the Capital 14 15 Development Board shall each appoint a liaison to serve 16 ex-officio on the Commission. The Office of the Governor, in 17 cooperation with the State agencies appointing liaisons to the Commission under this paragraph, shall provide administrative 18 19 support to the Commission.
