Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Commerce Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2013, as follows:

- Section 10. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.
- Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground
 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois
 Commerce Commission for refunds.
- Section 20. The sum of \$77,130,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission

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- 2 telephone system boards, qualified government entities, or
- 3 the Department of State Police for the design,
- 4 implementation, operation, maintenance, or upgrade of

- 12 Communications Commission wireless enhanced 9-1-1 services
- 13 mandates and for administrative costs incurred by the

- 17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated

Section 35. The sum of \$4,240,000, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation
Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1)
disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance
Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration
System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for
administrative expenses.

Section 40. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for railroad crossing improvement initiatives.
