13 Section 5. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 14 15 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the 16 17 Illinois Emergency Management Agency.

18 Section 10. The amount of \$20,000,000, or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 20 Homeland Security Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for current and prior year 21 22 expenses related to the federally funded Emergency 23 Preparedness Grant Program.

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1 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 3 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency 4 Management Agency for the ordinary and contingent expenses 5 incurred by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency.

6 Section 20. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Disaster 8 Response and Recovery Fund to the Illinois Emergency 9 Management Agency for all current and prior year expenses 10 associated with disaster response and recovery.

24 Section 55. The sum of \$1,350,000, or so much thereof as

necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 1 mav be Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 2 licensing facilities where radioactive uranium 3 for and thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related 4 costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning 5 6 of such facilities and for identification, decontamination environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties 7 and contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings. 8

9 Section 60. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as 10 necessary, is appropriated from the mav be Radiation Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 11 12 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental 13 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under cooperative agreements with the Federal Government. 14

The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as 15 Section 65. 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 17 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 18 19 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses 20 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 21 surety.

22 Section 70. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as

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1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 2 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 3 for local responder training, demonstrations, research, 4 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the 5 Federal Government.

Section 75. The sum of \$97,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 7 8 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency 9 Management Agency for related training and travel expenses 10 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 11 12 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, 13 high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste in Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency. 14

15 Section 80. The sum of \$271,200, or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed 17 Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for 18 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and 19 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site 20 near Sheffield, Illinois.

21 Section 85. The sum of \$990,000, or so much thereof as 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level 1 Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 2 the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use in accordance with Section 14(a) of the 3 Illinois Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related 4 to establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility. 5

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6 Section 90. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection Fund 8 to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for ordinary and 9 contingent expenses of the Illinois Emergency Management 10 Agency to include support of a centralized administrative 11 processing center.

12 Section 95. The sum of \$311,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 13 14 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency 15 Management Agency for ordinary and contingent expenses of the 16 Illinois Emergency Management Agency to include support of a 17 centralized administrative processing center.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2013.
