1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The sum of \$1,000,000,000, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary for statewide purposes, is appropriated 6 7 from the Transportation Bond Series D Fund to the Department 8 for preliminary engineering Transportation 9 construction engineering and contract costs of construction, 10 including reconstruction, extension and improvement of state and local highways, arterial highways, roads, access areas, 11 12 roadside shelters, rest areas, and fringe parking facilities 13 and sanitary facilities, and such other purposes as provided 14 by the "Illinois Highway Code"; for purposes allowed or 15 required by Title 23 of the U.S. Code; for bikeways as provided by Public Act 78-850; for land acquisition and 16 17 signboard removal and control and preservation of natural 18 beauty; and for capital improvements which directly 19 facilitate an effective vehicle weight enforcement program, such as scales (fixed and portable), scale pits and scale 20 21 installations and scale houses, in accordance with applicable 22 laws and regulations for the state and local portions of the
