history for the 5 years immediately preceding the date of

application on an application for employment with the agency if

- the position of employment requires or provides opportunity for 1
- 2 contact with persons with mental illness or developmental
- 3 disabilities.
- 4 (b) It is unlawful for a person to knowingly use a false
- 5 academic degree for the purpose of obtaining employment,
- 6 obtaining or admission to an institution of higher learning,
- 7 obtaining or admission to an advanced degree program at an
- institution of higher learning, or for the purpose of obtaining 8
- 9 a promotion or higher compensation in employment.
- 10 (c) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class A
- 11 misdemeanor.
