SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/90

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that the regulation, licensing, possession, registration, and transportation of accessories, components, attachments, or parts for handguns by licensees are exclusive powers and functions of the State. Provides that ordinances enacted that impose regulations or restrictions on accessories, components, attachments, or parts for handguns in a manner inconsistent with the Act shall be invalid in its application to licensees under the Act. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by changing Section 90 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 66/90)

- 90. Preemption. The regulation, licensing, 8 possession, registration, and transportation of handguns, and 9 ammunition, accessories, components, attachments, or parts for 10 handguns by licensees are exclusive powers and functions of the State. Any ordinance or regulation, or portion thereof, enacted 11 on or before the effective date of this Act that purports to 12 impose regulations or restrictions on licensees or handquns, 13 14 and ammunition, accessories, components, attachments, or parts for handguns in a manner inconsistent with this Act shall be 15 16 invalid in its application to licensees under this Act on the 17 effective date of this Act. This Section is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and functions under subsection 18 19 (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22 becoming law.
