## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/24-2.3 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Creates the offense of unlawful use of a three-dimensional printer to create a firearm. Provides that a person commits the offense when he or she uses a three-dimensional printer to create a firearm, or any piece or part of a firearm, unless the person possesses a license to manufacture firearms under the federal Gun Control Act of 1968. Provides that a violation is a Class A misdemeanor.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by adding Section 24-2.3 as follows:

- Sec. 24-2.3. Unlawful use of a three-dimensional printer to
- 8 <u>create a firearm.</u>
- 9 <u>(a) As used in this Section, "three-dimensional printer"</u>
  10 <u>means a computer-driven machine capable of producing a</u>
- 11 <u>three-dimensional object from a digital model.</u>
- 12 <u>(b) A person commits unlawful use of a three-dimensional</u>
- printer to create a firearm when he or she uses a
- 14 <u>three-dimensional printer to create a firearm, or any piece or</u>
- part of a firearm, unless the person possesses a license to
- 16 <u>manufacture firearms under subsection (a) of Section 923 of the</u>
- federal Gun Control Act of 1968 (18 U.S.C. 923(a)).
- 18 <u>(c) Sentence. Unlawful use of a three-dimensional printer</u>
- 19 <u>to create a firearm is a Class A misdemeanor.</u>
