SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-2b

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the program for medically fragile and technology dependent children.

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HB5123

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AN ACT concerning public aid.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 5-2b as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-2b)

7 5-2b. Medically fragile and technology dependent Sec. 8 children eligibility and program. Notwithstanding any other 9 provision of law, on and and after September 1, 2012, subject to federal approval, medical assistance under this Article 10 shall be available to children who qualify as persons with a 11 disability, as defined under the federal Supplemental Security 12 13 Income program and who are medically fragile and technology 14 dependent. The program shall allow eligible children to receive the medical assistance provided under this Article in the 15 community and must maximize, to the fullest extent permissible 16 17 under federal law, federal reimbursement and familv cost-sharing, including co-pays, premiums, or any other family 18 19 contributions, except that the Department shall be permitted to incentivize the utilization of selected services through the 20 21 of cost-sharing adjustments. The use Department shall 22 establish the policies, procedures, standards, services, and criteria for this program by rule. 23
