1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5490
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 5490 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
5	amended by changing Section 3.1 as follows:
6	(430 ILCS 65/3.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-3.1)
7	Sec. 3.1. Dial up system.
8	(a) The Department of State Police shall provide a dial up
9	telephone system or utilize other existing technology which
10	shall be used by any federally licensed firearm dealer, gun
11	show promoter, or gun show vendor who is to transfer a firearm,
12	stun gun, or taser under the provisions of this Act. The
13	Department of State Police may utilize existing technology
14	which allows the caller to be charged a fee not to exceed \$2.
15	Fees collected by the Department of State Police shall be
16	deposited in the State Police Services Fund and used to provide

## 1 the service. <u>A federally licensed firearm dealer may charge a</u> 2 <u>fee, not to exceed \$10, for the inquiry required under</u> 3 <u>subsection (b) of this Section.</u>

(b) Upon receiving a request from a federally licensed 4 5 firearm dealer, gun show promoter, or gun show vendor, the 6 Department of State Police shall immediately approve, or within the time period established by Section 24-3 of the Criminal 7 Code of 2012 regarding the delivery of firearms, stun guns, and 8 9 tasers notify the inquiring dealer, gun show promoter, or gun 10 show vendor of any objection that would disqualify the 11 transferee from acquiring or possessing a firearm, stun gun, or taser. In conducting the inquiry, the Department of State 12 13 Police shall initiate and complete an automated search of its criminal history record information files and those of the 14 15 Federal Bureau of Investigation, including the National 16 Instant Criminal Background Check System, and of the files of the Department of Human Services relating to mental health and 17 developmental disabilities to obtain any felony conviction or 18 19 patient hospitalization information which would disqualify a 20 person from obtaining or require revocation of a currently valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card. 21

(c) If receipt of a firearm would not violate Section 24-3
of the Criminal Code of 2012, federal law, or this Act the
Department of State Police shall:

25 (1) assign a unique identification number to the 26 transfer; and 1 2 (2) provide the licensee, gun show promoter, or gun show vendor with the number.

3 (d) Approvals issued by the Department of State Police for 4 the purchase of a firearm are valid for 30 days from the date 5 of issue.

6 (e) (1) The Department of State Police must act as the 7 Illinois Point of Contact for the National Instant Criminal 8 Background Check System.

9 (2) The Department of State Police and the Department of 10 Human Services shall, in accordance with State and federal law 11 regarding confidentiality, enter into а memorandum of understanding with the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the 12 implementing the National 13 of Instant Criminal purpose 14 Background Check System in the State. The Department of State 15 Police shall report the name, date of birth, and physical 16 description of any person prohibited from possessing a firearm pursuant to the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act or 18 17 U.S.C. 922(q) and (n) to the National Instant Criminal 18 19 Background Check System Index, Denied Persons Files.

(3) The Department of State Police shall provide notice of the disqualification of a person under subsection (b) of this Section or the revocation of a person's Firearm Owner's Identification Card under Section 8 of this Act, and the reason for the disqualification or revocation, to all law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction to assist with the seizure of the person's Firearm Owner's Identification Card. 09800HB5490ham001 -4- LRB098 17543 RLC 56220 a

(f) The Department of State Police shall adopt rules not
 inconsistent with this Section to implement this system.
