## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Health Information Exchange and
- 5 Technology Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3860/1)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2021)
- 8 Sec. 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the the
- 9 Illinois Health Information Exchange and Technology Act.

- 11 Section 10. The Court of Claims Act is amended by changing
- 12 Section 1 as follows:
- 13 (705 ILCS 505/1) (from Ch. 37, par. 439.1)
- 14 Sec. 1. The Court of Claims, hereinafter called the court,
- is created. It shall consist of 7 judges, who are attorneys
- licensed to practice law in the the State of Illinois, to be
- appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of
- 18 the Senate, one of whom shall be appointed chief justice. In
- 19 case of vacancy in such office during the recess of the Senate,
- the Governor shall make a temporary appointment until the next
- 21 meeting of the Senate, when he shall nominate some person to

- fill such office. If the Senate is not in session at the time
- 2 this Act takes effect, the Governor shall make temporary
- 3 appointments as in case of vacancy.
