SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

605 ILCS 5/4-224 new

Amends the Illinois Highway Code. Provides that the Department of Transportation may analyze the State highway system to identify areas, such as rest stops or improved shoulders, where vehicles may safely stop for the purpose of using a cell phone or other communication device. Provides that the Department of Transportation may erect signs alerting drivers to the presence of these areas.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by adding Section 4-224 as follows:
- 6 (605 ILCS 5/4-224 new)

- 7 <u>Sec. 4-224. Communication Zones.</u>
- 8 (a) The Department may conduct an analysis of the State
 9 highway system to identify areas along State highways where
 10 drivers may safely exit the flow of traffic and stop for the
 11 purpose of using an electronic communications device as defined
 12 by Section 12-610.2 of the Illinois Vehicle Code. These areas
 13 may include but are not limited to rest stops and improved or
 - (b) After identifying areas where vehicles may safely stop for the purpose of using electronic communication devices under subsection (a) of this Section, the Department may erect appropriate blue and white signs alerting drivers to the existence and location of these areas.
