# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by 5 changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 705/1) (from Ch. 85, par. 501)

7 Sec. 1. It is hereby declared as a matter of legislative 8 determination that that in order to promote and protect citizen 9 health, safety and welfare, it is necessary and in the public 10 interest to provide for the creation of the Illinois Law Training Standards Board for the purpose of 11 Enforcement 12 aiding municipalities, counties, encouraging and park 13 districts, State controlled universities, colleges, and public 14 community colleges, and other local governmental agencies of this State and participating State agencies in their efforts to 15 16 raise the level of law enforcement by upgrading and maintaining a high level of training and standards for law enforcement 17 officers, county corrections 18 executives and officers, 19 sheriffs, county coroners, and law enforcement support 20 under this Act. It is declared to personnel be the 21 responsibility of the board to ensure the required 22 participation of the pertinent local governmental units in the programs established under this Act, to encourage the voluntary 23

1 participation of other local governmental units and 2 participating State agencies, to set standards, develop and 3 provide quality training and education, and to aid in the 4 establishment of adequate training facilities.
