SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/2-138 from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 2-138 40 ILCS 5/14-135.09 from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 14-135.09 40 ILCS 5/15-169 from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 15-169 40 ILCS 5/16-180.1 new 40 ILCS 5/18-145 from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 18-145

Amends the Illinois Pension Code. Provides that the 5 State-funded retirement systems may not enter into any new contract, or extend or renew any existing contract, under which System funds are used to compensate a contract lobbyist. Effective immediately.

PENSION IMPACT NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing Sections 2-138, 14-135.09, 15-169, and 18-145 and by adding Section 16-180.1 as follows:
- 7 (40 ILCS 5/2-138) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 2-138)
- 8 Sec. 2-138. To hire employees.
- To appoint a secretary and employ such other actuarial, medical, clerical or other help as shall be required for the efficient administration of the system and to determine and fix
- 12 their rate of pay.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, the
- 14 System may not enter into any new contract, or extend or renew
- any existing contract, under which System funds are used to
- 16 compensate a contract lobbyist.

- 20 the "Personnel Code", approved July 18, 1955, as now or
- 21 hereafter amended, an executive secretary, an actuary and such
- 22 medical and other services as shall be required to transact the

- 1 business of the system; and to pay the expenses of the board
- 2 necessary for the operation of the system at such rates and in
- 3 such amounts as the board determines and approves.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, the
- 5 System may not enter into any new contract, or extend or renew
- 6 any existing contract, under which System funds are used to
- 7 <u>compensate a contract lobbyist.</u>

- 10 Sec. 15-169. To elect officers and appoint employees. To
- 11 elect officers; to appoint a secretary and treasurer; to have a
- 12 seal; to employ and fix the rate of pay of such actuarial,
- 13 legal, clerical, audit, medical, or other services, or
- 14 corporate trustee organized under the laws of this State with a
- capital of not less than \$1,000,000, or investment counsel and
- 16 other persons as shall be required for the efficient
- 17 administration of the system. All actions brought by or against
- 18 the board shall be prosecuted or defended by the Attorney
- 19 General. If the board pursues a mandamus action under Section
- 20 15-156 of this Code as amended by Senate Bill No. 1 of the 98th
- 21 General Assembly in the form passed by the General Assembly,
- then the board may select the counsel of their choice.

- 18 System may not enter into any new contract, or extend or renew
- 19 any existing contract, under which System funds are used to
- 20 compensate a contract lobbyist.
