

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
8 of the Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
10 June 30, 2015:

11 Payable from the Education Assistance Fund:

12	For Personal Services, including payment	
13	to the university for personal services	
14	costs incurred during the fiscal year	
15	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic	
16	personnel for personal services rendered	
17	during the academic year 2014-2015	520,235,200
18	For State Contributions to Social	
19	Security, for Medicare	9,737,100
20	For Group Insurance	24,893,200
21	For Contractual Services	37,000,000
22	For costs associated with the School of

7 Section 10. The sum of \$16,826,500, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
10 for costs and expenses related to or in support of the
11 Prairie Research Institute, in accordance with Public Act 95-
12 0728.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$45,000,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
16 for operating costs and expenses related to or in support of
17 the University of Illinois Hospital.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$750,900, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
20 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
21 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for
22 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

1 Section 25. The sum of \$308,200, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
3 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
4 Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$1,173,200, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
8 Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy
9 Institute at the Chicago campus.

10 Section 35. The sum of \$328,500, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
12 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
13 Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

14 Section 40. The sum of \$3,721,300, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
16 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
17 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
18 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
19 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment
20 to the University for personal services and related costs
21 incurred.

1 Section 45. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
3 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
4 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
5 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

6 Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public
8 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
9 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito
10 Abatement.

11 Section 55. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
13 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
14 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
15 abatement.

16 Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
18 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
19 and contingent expenses.

20 Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
2 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
3 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
4 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
5 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
6 Rockford.
