Section 55. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.

7 Section 60. The sum of \$620,000, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 9 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 10 for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 11 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses 12 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 13 surety.

14 Section 65. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as Radiation 15 is appropriated from the mav be necessary, 16 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 17 local responder training, demonstrations, research, for 18 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the 19 Federal Government.

7 Section 75. The sum of \$271,200, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed 9 Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for 10 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and 11 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site 12 near Sheffield, Illinois.

13 Section 80. The sum of \$990,000, or so much thereof as 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level 15 Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 16 the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use in accordance with Section 14(a) of the 17 Illinois Low-Level 18 Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related to 19 establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility.

20 Section 85. The sum of \$230,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 22 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency HB6075 -13- OMB098 00453 AXW 30453 b Management Agency for ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency to include support of a centralized administrative processing center.
