

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the  
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal  
9 Justice Information Authority:

11 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

3 Section 10. The sum of \$10,207,800, or so much thereof  
 4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 5 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
 6 for administrative costs, awards and grants for the Adult  
 7 Redeploy and Diversion programs.

8 Section 15. The sum of \$42,500,000, or so much thereof  
 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal  
 10 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice  
 11 Information Authority for awards and grants to local units of  
 12 government and non-profit organizations.

13 Section 20. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof  
 14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal  
 15 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice  
 16 Information Authority for awards and grants to state  
 17 agencies.

18 Section 25. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
 19 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
 20 Criminal Justice Information Authority for activities  
 21 undertaken in support of federal assistance programs

1 administered by units of state and local government and non-  
2 profit organizations:

3 Payable from the Criminal Justice  
4 Trust Fund .....5,800,000

5 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
7 Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants  
8 and other monies received from federal agencies, from other  
9 units of government, and from private/not-for-profit  
10 organizations for activities undertaken in support of  
11 investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking  
12 other criminal justice information projects:

13 Payable from the Criminal Justice  
14 Trust Fund .....1,700,000  
15 Payable from the Criminal Justice  
16 Information Projects Fund .....1,000,000  
17 Total \$2,700,000

18 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much  
19 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
20 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the  
21 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards,  
22 grants and operational support to implement the Motor Vehicle  
23 Theft Prevention Act:

15       Section 40. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois State  
17 Crime Stoppers Association Fund to the Illinois Criminal  
18 Justice Information Authority for grants to enhance and  
19 develop Crime Stoppers programs in Illinois.

20       Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much  
21 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
22 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the  
23 Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the

1 training of law enforcement personnel and services for  
2 families of homicide or murder:

16 Section 50. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Prescription Pill  
18 and Drug Disposal Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice  
19 Information Authority for the purpose of collection,  
20 transportation, and incineration of pharmaceuticals by local  
21 law enforcement agencies.

22 Section 55. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
23 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the

1 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and  
 2 contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice  
 3 Information Authority:

19 Section 60. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICJIA Violence  
 21 Prevention Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information  
 22 Authority for the purpose of awarding grants under the  
 23 provisions of the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

1           Section 65. The amount of \$528,300, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
4 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council  
5 Program.

6           Section 70. The amount of \$4,400,000, or so much thereof  
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
9 for grants and administrative expenses related to Operation  
10 CeaseFire.

11          Section 75. The amount of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
13 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
14 for grants and administrative expenses for Franklin County  
15 Juvenile Detention Center for Methamphetamine Pilot Program.

16          Section 80. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof  
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
18 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
19 for a grant to the South Suburban Major Crimes Task Force.

20          Section 85. The amount of \$1,800,000, or so much thereof  
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
2 for grants and administrative expenses related to Operation  
3 CeaseFire for the following areas: Rockford, Springfield,  
4 Peoria, Rock Island, South Suburban Cook County, and the  
5 Metro East area including Belleville and Alton.

6 Section 90. The amount of \$650,000, or so much thereof  
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority  
9 for all costs associated with Bullying Prevention.

10 Section 95. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much  
11 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
12 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information  
13 Authority for grants and administrative expenses associated  
14 with before and after school programs.

#### ARTICLE 99

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July  
16 1, 2014.
