11 Section 20. The amounts appropriated for repairs and 12 maintenance, and other capital improvements in Section 10 for 13 repairs and maintenance, roof repairs and/or replacements and capital improvements at the 14 miscellaneous Department's 15 various institutions are to include construction, 16 reconstruction, improvements, repairs and installation of 17 capital facilities, costs of planning, supplies, materials and all other expenses required for roof and other types of 18 repairs and maintenance, capital improvements, and purchase 19 20 of land.

No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from appropriations made in Section 10 of this Article until after the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing

- 1 by the Governor.
- 2 Section 25. The sum of \$40,100, or so much thereof as
- 3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of
- 4 Juvenile Justice from the General Revenue Fund for costs and
- 5 expenses associated with payment of statewide
- 6 hospitalization.
- 7 Section 30. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
- 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 9 Fund to the Department of Juvenile Justice for the purposes
- 10 of investigating complaints, evaluating policies and
- 11 procedures, and securing the rights of the youth committed to
- 12 the Department of Juvenile Justice, including youth released
- on Aftercare before final discharge.
- 14 ARTICLE 99
- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 16 2014.".
