1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Gaming
9 Board:

14 Section 5. The sum of \$161,000, or so much thereof as
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund
 16 to the Illinois Gaming Board for costs and expenses related
 17 to or in support of a Government Services Shared Services
 18 Center.

19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
 20 1, 2014.
