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## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Prior to October of 2010, the overwhelming 3 majority of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) 4 benefits were distributed on the 1st of the month in Illinois; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, Due to the SNAP distribution schedule, customers 7 were relegated to shopping in crowded stores with elevated 8 security, stores were unable to offer a high level of customer 9 service due to the size of the crowds, customers who shopped 10 later in the month found empty store shelves and diminished 11 access to fresh fruits and vegetables, and employees saw their 12 hours cut; and

13 WHEREAS, The narrow SNAP distribution schedule caused 14 for Illinois enormous operational issues qrocers and retailers, especially for those businesses that operated in 15 areas with a high density of customers that purchased food with 16 SNAP funds; and 17

18 WHEREAS, The SNAP distribution schedule also created 19 significant operational issues for food banks, which 20 experienced a dramatic increase in families in need at the end 21 of the month when SNAP benefits ran out; and HJ0043 -2- LRB098 12247 GRL 46391 r WHEREAS, In October of 2010, after many meetings with representatives of the grocery industry and non-profit groups that have an interest in food access for low-income residents, the Illinois Department of Human Services instituted a change in how SNAP benefits were distributed to Illinois residents; and

7 WHEREAS, In order to relieve the pressure off of businesses 8 and customers at the first of the month, a large number of SNAP 9 customers were shifted from the first of the month to the 4th, 10 7th, and 10th of the month over the period of one year with 11 great success; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services currently issues
SNAP benefits on the 1st, 3rd, 4th, 7th, 8th, 10th, 11th, 14th,
17th, 19th, 21st, and 23rd days of the month; and

15 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services has decided to 16 shrink the SNAP distribution dates to the first 10 days of the 17 month; and

18 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Agriculture 19 (USDA), which controls the funding for the SNAP program, sent a 20 letter to each state encouraging states to spread SNAP 21 distribution evenly throughout the month; and HJ0043 -3- LRB098 12247 GRL 46391 r WHEREAS, This change goes in the opposite direction of the advocacy position taken by the USDA and the movement of other states in recent years, changing their systems to distribute SNAP benefits evenly throughout the month; therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 6 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE 7 SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Task Force on the Efficient 8 Distribution of SNAP Benefits is created; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall consist of the 10 following 10 members, appointed as follows:

(1) four legislators, appointed one each by the President of the Senate, the Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives;

15 (2) the Secretary of the Illinois Department of Human16 Services or his or her designee;

17 (3) one person appointed by the Governor to represent a
18 state-wide association exclusively representing retailers;

19 (4) one person appointed by the Governor to represent a
20 state-wide association exclusively representing grocers;

(5) one person appointed by the Governor to represent a non-profit organization focusing on advancing justice and opportunity for low-income Illinois residents; and

24 (6) one person appointed by the Governor to represent a

3 RESOLVED, That the co-chairs of the Task Force shall invite 4 representatives of the USDA to participate in the Task Force; 5 and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That the designee of the Speaker of the House of 7 Representatives and the designee of the Senate President shall 8 serve as co-chairs of the Task Force; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the members of the Task Force shall be 10 appointed no later than 30 days after the effective date of 11 this resolution; the members of the Task Force shall not 12 receive compensation; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That the Department of Human Services shall 14 provide administrative support to the Task Force; and be it 15 further

16 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall prepare a report that 17 details how SNAP benefits can be distributed more evenly 18 throughout the month in the State of Illinois and shall submit 19 this report to the Governor and the General Assembly by October 20 1, 2013; and be it further HJ0043 -5- LRB098 12247 GRL 46391 r 1 RESOLVED, That the Task Force, upon issuing the report, is 2 dissolved effective October 1, 2013.
