10 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES RESOLVED, BY THE THE 11 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the School 12 13 Povertv Task Force to study sources of funding 14 poverty-stricken schools throughout the State of Illinois; and be it further 15

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall study possible solutions and new methods for State funding, including General State Aid and poverty grant funding, in order to give advice on how school funding can be more equally distributed to schools in the State; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Illinois State Board of Education shall

- 1 provide administrative support to the Task Force; and be it
- 2 further

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- RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall consist of the following members:
- 5 (1) one member appointed by the Governor;
- 6 (2) one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
- 8 (3) one member appointed by the President of the 9 Senate:
 - (4) one member appointed by the Illinois State Board of Education;
- 12 (5) one member appointed by the Illinois Department of Human Services;
 - (6) one member with expertise in poverty, appointed by a non-profit group involved in poverty-stricken schools in the State; and
 - (7) one member to serve as a representative of teacher unions in the State, appointed by election from all major teacher unions in the State; and be it further
 - RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall meet initially at the call of the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate, submit a report to the General Assembly no later than October 31, 2014, and, upon submission, be dissolved; and be it further

- 2 delivered to the Governor, the Illinois State Board of
- 3 Education, and the Illinois Department of Human Services.
