HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

HC0021

Introduced , by Rep. Bill Mitchell

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. VIII, Sec. 2

Proposes to amend the Finance Article of the Illinois Constitution. Except upon a three-fifths vote of each house of the General Assembly, limits each fiscal year's increase in total aggregate appropriations to the greater of 4% of the previous fiscal year's total aggregate appropriations or the sum of the rate of inflation and the State's population growth since the previous fiscal year. Requires that revenues in excess of a fiscal year's total aggregate appropriations must be deposited into a rainy day fund within the State treasury. Provides that moneys appropriated for elementary or secondary education, and moneys appropriated to any public or private university or community college in the State, shall not be included as part of the State's aggregate appropriations in any fiscal year. Effective upon being declared adopted.

3 RESOLVED, ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 4 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE 5 SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the 6 electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of 7 8 this resolution a proposition to amend Article VIII of the 9 Illinois Constitution by changing Section 2 as follows:

13 SECTION 2. STATE FINANCE

14 (a) The Governor shall prepare and submit to the General Assembly, at a time prescribed by law, a State budget for the 15 ensuing fiscal year. The budget shall set forth the estimated 16 17 balance of funds available for appropriation at the beginning of the fiscal year, the estimated receipts, and a plan for 18 19 expenditures and obligations during the fiscal year of every 20 department, authority, public corporation and quasi-public corporation of the State, every State college and university, 21 and every other public agency created by the State, but not of 22 23 units of local government or school districts. The budget shall also set forth the indebtedness and contingent liabilities of
the State and such other information as may be required by law.
Proposed expenditures shall not exceed funds estimated to be
available for the fiscal year as shown in the budget.

5 (b) The General Assembly by law shall make appropriations 6 for all expenditures of public funds by the State. 7 Appropriations for a fiscal year shall not exceed funds 8 estimated by the General Assembly to be available during that 9 year.

10 (c) Except upon a record vote of three-fifths of the 11 members elected to each house of the General Assembly, the 12 total aggregate appropriations for each fiscal year shall not 13 the previous fiscal year's total aggregate exceed 14 appropriations by the greater of 4% of the previous fiscal year's total aggregate appropriations or a percentage 15 16 representing the sum of the percentage rate of inflation and 17 the percentage rate of the State's population growth since the previous fiscal year. State revenues in excess of a fiscal 18 19 year's total aggregate appropriations as calculated under this 20 subsection shall be deposited into a rainy day fund within the 21 State treasury established and to be used for purposes provided 22 by law. Moneys appropriated for elementary or secondary 23 education, and moneys appropriated to any public or private 24 university or community college in the State, shall not be 25 included as part of the State's aggregate appropriations in any 26 fiscal year.
