HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The recent school shooting at Sandy Hook
3 Elementary in Newtown, Connecticut, highlights the need to
4 improve security at our nation's public schools; and

5 WHEREAS, Security at our State's public schools could be
6 vastly increased if State and local law enforcement agencies
7 and public school districts cooperated with one another to
8 increase the presence of law enforcement officials in and
9 around public schools; therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
11 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
12 we encourage State and local law enforcement agencies and
13 public school districts in the State to cooperate with one
14 another to establish school walk-through programs that would
15 permit State and local law enforcement officials to more
16 frequently stop and walk through public school properties
17 during their patrols and thereby increase the security of those
18 properties; and be it further

19 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
20 delivered to each regional superintendent of schools, the
21 President of the Illinois Sheriffs' Association, the President
22 of the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police, and the
