HOUSE RESOLUTION 169

2 WHEREAS, The executive board of the International Olympic 3 Committee (IOC) reviewed 26 sports on its summer program and 4 decided to eliminate wrestling as an Olympic sport, stunning 5 the world's wrestlers, who see their sport as popular and 6 steeped in history as old as the Olympics themselves; and

7 WHEREAS, While wrestling will be included at the 2016
8 Olympics in Rio de Janeiro, it will not be included in the 2020
9 Olympic Games; and

10 WHEREAS, The executive board of the IOC voted after 11 reviewing an IOC program commission report that analyzed 39 12 criteria, including TV ratings, ticket sales, global 13 participation, and popularity; and

14 WHEREAS, According to IOC documents, wrestling ranked 15 "low" in several of the technical criteria; and

16 WHEREAS, The decision to phase out wrestling will have a 17 detrimental impact on many teams around the world, including 18 the United States, whose wrestling medals are only outnumbered 19 by swimming and track and field; and

20 WHEREAS, Wrestling is also one of the most popular youth

3 WHEREAS, Illinois has the second most high school wrestlers 4 in any state in the nation, with 17,112 high school boys and 5 girls wrestling in the 2011-2012 year; and

6 WHEREAS, The Illinois Kids Wrestling Federation, USA 7 Wrestling's state association in Illinois for wrestlers 8 between the ages of 5-13, has the largest membership in the 9 nation within USA Wrestling, with almost 19,000 members last 10 year and a complete program of events and opportunities for 11 wrestlers of all levels in the State; and

12 WHEREAS, Illinois is also active in college wrestling 13 through 18 college programs, including the Division I programs 14 at Northern Illinois University, Northwestern University, Southern Illinois University, and the University of Illinois; 15 16 the Division II program at McKendree College; and the Division III programs at Augustana College, Elmhurst College, Knox 17 College, North Central College, the University of Chicago, and 18 19 Wheaton College, as well as the Junior College programs at 20 Kennedy-King College, Lincoln College, Rend Lake College, Triton College, Waubonsee Community College, Wilbur Wright 21 22 College, and William Rainey Harper College; and

WHEREAS, Abraham Lincoln, when living in New Salem, was an
accomplished wrestler and was once considered one of the best
in the Midwest in the early 1830s; according to the National
Wrestling Hall of Fame, Lincoln had only one recorded defeat in
12 years; and

6 WHEREAS, Wrestling is a diverse, popular, and historic 7 sport, and it is fitting and proper that the IOC keep wrestling 8 in the Olympic Games after the 2016 Olympics in Rio de Janeiro, 9 Brazil; therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 11 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we request that the IOC revisit their decision to drop 12 13 wrestling from the Olympic Games after the 2016 Games in Rio de 14 Janeiro, Brazil, and urge them to keep it as an Olympic sport; 15 and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 17 delivered to Richard Bender, Executive Director of USA 18 Wrestling; James Considine, Illinois State Director of USA 19 Wrestling; and the United States Olympic Committee.
