1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Weather radios are designed to receive the 2 3 National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Weather 4 Radio service's broadcast, which provides around-the-clock 5 weather information; and 6 WHEREAS, Weather radios can also respond to the Federal 7 Communications Commission's Emergency Alert System and alert 8 signals sent by the NOAA Weather Radio service; and 9 WHEREAS, Weather radios sound an alarm to warn those in the 10 area of dangerous weather when they receive an alert signal; 11 and 12 WHEREAS, Weather radios send information on hazardous 13 weather conditions 24 hours a day in all 50 states; and 14 WHEREAS, The National Weather Service issues 50,000 weather warnings per year; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Over 98% of the United States population is 17 covered by NOAA Weather Radio broadcasts; and WHEREAS, While many outdoor weather sirens can only be 18 19 heard outdoors, weather radios can be heard indoors; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Mobile home residents make up just 7% of the
- 2 United States population, but account for 40% of the deaths in
- 3 tornadoes; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Extreme weather can occur with very little notice
- 5 and present an imminent danger to Illinois citizens, especially
- 6 those in mobile homes; and
- WHEREAS, Weather radios are a life-saving tool that will
- 8 help protect the people of Illinois from weather emergencies;
- 9 therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 11 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 12 we urge every contractor or manufacturer building new
- 13 residences in the State, especially mobile homes, to install a
- 14 weather radio within each residence in order to provide the
- 15 citizens of this State adequate protection during inclement
- weather.
