1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 206

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 206 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Secretary of State Merit Employment Code is
5 amended by changing Section 12 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 310/12) (from Ch. 124, par. 112)

7 Sec. 12. Employees of the Office of the Secretary of State
8 - election to public office - leave of absence - re-entry of
9 service. Any person holding a position in the Office of the
10 Secretary of State, who is elected to public office, may ~~shall~~,
11 upon request, be granted a leave of absence, without pay, from
12 such position. The leave of absence shall continue so long as
13 he remains an elected officer or for a period of 5 years,
14 whichever is shorter ~~and for a period of 30 calendar days~~
15 ~~thereafter.~~

16 If such person files a written request with the Director of

1 Personnel to re-enter active service with the Office of the
2 Secretary of State within a 30-day period following the
3 termination of his leave, ~~such 30 day period~~ he may ~~shall~~ be
4 reinstated to his former position or a position of comparable
5 duties, responsibilities and pay.
