3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.
4 1, on page 3, by replacing lines 13 through 19 with the

7 Sec. 1-23. Permitting timeframe. Notwithstanding any other
8 provision of law, high volume horizontal fracturing operations
9 shall only be allowed under this Act:

11 Bond, Calhoun, Christian, Clark, Clay, Clinton, Coles,
12 Crawford, Cumberland, Douglas, Edgar, Edwards, Effingham,

6 Henderson, Henry, Iroquois, Jo Daviess, Knox, La Salle,
7 Lee, Livingston, Logan, Macon, Marshall, Mason, McDonough,
8 McLean, Menard, Mercer, Morgan, Ogle, Peoria, Piatt, Pike,
9 Putnam, Rock Island, Sangamon, Schuyler, Scott, Stark,
10 Stephenson, Tazewell, Vermilion, Warren, Whiteside,
