2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 5 changing Section 16-101 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 5/16-101) (from Ch. 110, par. 16-101)

7 Sec. 16-101. Availability of remedy. Relief by ne exeat republica may be granted, in cases where the the debt or claim 8 9 is not actually due, but exists fairly and bona fide in expectancy at the time of making application, and in cases 10 11 where the claim is due; and it is not necessary, to authorize the granting of such relief by ne exeat, that the applicant 12 show that his or her debt or claim is purely of an equitable 13 14 character.
