Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section regarding pedestrians.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 11-1001 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1001) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1001)
- Sec. 11-1001. Pedestrian obedience <u>to</u> traffic control devices and traffic regulations.
- 9 (a) A pedestrian shall obey the instructions of any 10 official traffic control device specifically applicable to 11 him, unless otherwise directed by a police officer.
- (b) Pedestrians shall be subject to traffic and pedestrian control signals provided in Sections 11-306 and 11-307 of this Chapter, but at all other places pedestrians shall be accorded the privileges and shall be subject to the restrictions stated in this Article.
