3	everything after the enacting clause with the fo	ollowing:
4	"Section 5. The School Construction Law	is amended by
5	changing Section 5-40 as follows:

7	Sec. 5-40. Supervision of school constru	ction projects;
8	green projects. The Capital Development Board	shall exercise
9	general supervision over school construction pr	ojects financed
10	pursuant to this Article. School districts, h	owever, must be
11	allowed to choose the architect and engineer f	or their school
12	construction projects, and no project may be dia	sapproved by the
13	State Board of Education or the Capital De	velopment Board
14	solely due to a school district's selection of	an architect or
15	engineer.	
16	With respect to those school construction	on projects for

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1 which a school district first applies for a grant on or after July 1, 2007, the school construction project must receive 2 3 certification from the United States Green Building Council's 4 Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design Green Building 5 Rating System or the Green Building Initiative's Green Globes 6 Green Building Rating System or must meet green building standards of the Capital Development Board and its Green 7 Building Advisory Committee. With respect to those school 8 9 construction projects for which a school district applies for a 10 grant on or after July 1, 2009, the school construction project 11 must receive silver certification from the United States Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental 12 13 Design Green Building Rating System unless all of the following 14 are met:

15 <u>(1) the application submitted can be categorized as a</u> 16 <u>capital need prioritized under item (1) of Section 5-30 of</u> 17 <u>this Law;</u>

18 (2) the renovation or replacement school construction 19 project is less than 40% replacement cost, or the project 20 has been granted a waiver by the Capital Development Board 21 in consultation with the State Board of Education in 22 accordance with rules promulgated pursuant to this Law;

23 <u>(3) the school construction project is located in a</u>
24 <u>county that borders the Mississippi River with a population</u>
25 <u>of more than 33,000 and less than 34,000, according to the</u>
26 <u>2010 decennial census;</u>

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1 (4) the school district for which the school 2 construction grant will be issued has no more than 1,100 students, with the relevant school facility housing no more 3 4 than 700 students; 5 (5) the facilities for which the school construction 6 grant will be used have been condemned as of July 23, 2012; 7 and (6) the application for the school construction grant 8 9 has been approved prior to the effective date of this 10 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.
