1 may apply to the circuit court of the county in which the piece 2 or parcel of land is situated by petition in writing for leave to sell that parcel. Notice of such application shall be given 3 4 by the board of park commissioners in some newspaper published 5 in the county at least 10 days before the day named therein 6 stating when the application will be made. All persons interested may appear before the circuit court either in person 7 8 or by attorney when the application is made and object to the 9 granting of the application. After hearing all persons 10 interested, if the court deems the granting of the application 11 to be for the public interest, it shall direct that the property mentioned in the application, or any part thereof, be 12 13 sold and conveyed by the board of park commissioners upon such terms and conditions as the court may think proper. 14
