14	on page 10, by replacing lines 7	through 19 with the	following:
15	"If any applicant's househ	old contains a per	rson with a
16	disability who is a dependent	of the applicant	and if that

1	person's income is not reported as part of the applicant's	
2	household income on an application for an exemption under this	
3	Section, then that applicant shall submit proof of the	
4	disability in such form and manner as the Department shall by	
5	rule and regulation prescribe. Proof that the person with a	
6	disability is eligible to receive disability benefits under the	
7	Federal Social Security Act shall constitute proof of	
8	disability for purposes of this Act. Issuance of an Illinois	
9	Person with a Disability Identification Card stating that the	
10	person with a disability is under a Class 2 disability, as	
11	defined in Section 4A of the Illinois Identification Card Act,	
12	shall constitute proof that the person named thereon is a	
13	disabled person for purposes of this Act. A disabled person not	
14	covered under the Federal Social Security Act and not	
15	presenting an Illinois Person with a Disability Identification	
16	Card stating that the claimant is under a Class 2 disability	
17	shall be examined by a physician designated by the Department,	
18	and his status as a disabled person determined using the same	
19	standards as used by the Social Security Administration. The	
20	costs of any required examination shall be borne by the	
21	applicant.".
