SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/13.1

from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that a county, including a home rule county, may not regulate firearms or impose greater restrictions or limitations on the acquisition, possession, transportation, carrying, and transfer of firearms, firearm attachments, and firearm ammunition. Further provides that the provisions of any ordinance or resolution imposing restrictions or limitations on the ownership or possession of firearms and ammunition, components, accessories, and accourrements of firearms in a manner other than the requirements imposed by this Act or the Deadly Weapons Article of the Criminal Code of 2012 on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act are invalid and all those existing ordinances and resolution are void. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning firearms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is amended by changing Section 13.1 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/13.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1)
- Sec. 13.1. <u>Municipal regulation; county regulation</u>

 8 preempted.
- 9 <u>(a)</u> The provisions of any ordinance enacted by any 10 municipality which requires registration or imposes greater 11 restrictions or limitations on the acquisition, possession and 12 transfer of firearms than are imposed by this Act, are not 13 invalidated or affected by this Act.
- 14 (b) A county, including a home rule county, may not regulate firearms or impose greater restrictions or 15 limitations on the acquisition, possession, transportation, 16 17 carrying, and transfer of firearms, firearm attachments, and firearm ammunition. The provisions of any ordinance or 18 19 resolution on or after the effective date of this amendatory 20 Act of the 98th General Assembly by any county government that 21 imposes restrictions or limitations on the ownership or 22 possession of firearms and ammunition, components, accessories, and accoutrements of firearms in a manner other 23

- than the requirements that are imposed by this Act or Article
- 2 <u>24 of the Criminal Code of 2012 are invalid and all those</u>
- 3 existing ordinances and resolutions are void. This subsection
- 4 is a limitation of home rule powers under subsection (h) of
- 5 Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.
