Amends the Transportation Article of the School Code. Provides that the Section concerning transportation to and from specified interscholastic or school-sponsored activities does not apply to transition students who have completed grades 9 through 12.

AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
29-6.3 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/29-6.3)

Sec. 29-6.3. Transportation to and from specified
interscholastic or school-sponsored activities.

9 (a) Any school district transporting students in grade 12 or below for an interscholastic, interscholastic athletic, or 10 school-sponsored, noncurriculum-related activity that (i) does 11 not require student participation as part of the educational 12 services of the district and (ii) is not associated with the 13 14 students' regular class-for-credit schedule or required 5 clock hours of instruction shall transport the students only in 15 16 a school bus, a vehicle manufactured to transport not more than 17 persons, including the driver, or a multifunction 10 school-activity bus manufactured to transport not more than 15 18 19 persons, including the driver.

20 (a-5) A student in any of grades 9 through 12 may be 21 transported in a multi-function school activity bus (MFSAB) as 22 defined in Section 1-148.3a-5 of the Illinois Vehicle Code for 23 any curriculum-related activity except for transportation on - 2 - LRB098 09583 NHT 39729 b

1 regular bus routes from home to school or from school to home,
2 subject to the following conditions:

3 (i) A MFSAB may not be used to transport students under
4 this Section unless the driver holds a valid school bus
5 driver permit.

6 (ii) The use of a MFSAB under this Section is subject
7 to the requirements of Sections 6-106.11, 6-106.12,
8 12-707.01, 13-101, and 13-109 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

9 (b) Any school district furnishing transportation for 10 students under the authority of this Section shall insure 11 against any loss or liability of the district resulting from 12 the maintenance, operation, or use of the vehicle.

13 (c) Vehicles used to transport students under this Section 14 may claim a depreciation allowance of 20% over 5 years as 15 provided in Section 29-5 of this Code.

16 (d) This Section does not apply to transition students who 17 <u>have completed grades 9 through 12.</u>
