1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2244 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 2244 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Tanning Facility Permit Act is amended by 4 5 changing Section 25 as follows: (210 ILCS 145/25) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 8351-25) 6 7 Sec. 25. Operating requirements. (1) Each tanning facility shall have on hand at all times 8 an operator adequately trained in the correct operation of the 9 10 facility so as to be able to inform and assist the public in 11 its proper use. Each operator shall perform the following 12 functions as a precondition to the public having access to the 13 tanning facility being made to the public: (a) The operator shall require each person desiring to 14 15 use the facility to fill out a form specifying any and all

they are presently taking. The form shall be kept as a permanent record of the individual's attendance and progress.

- (b) The operator shall require each person desiring to use a tanning facility to use protective eyewear.
- (c) The operator shall instruct the user in the proper position to maintain in relation to the tanning lamps within the facility; the position of the safety railing, if applicable; the manual switching device to terminate the radiation in case of emergency; and a recommended time of exposure.
- (d) The operator shall monitor the use of the facility to ensure that the interior temperature does not exceed 100 degrees fahrenheit or 34 degrees centigrade.
- (e) The operator shall inspect the facility to ensure that the floors are dry. The floors are to be made dry prior to each individual's use.
- (f) The operator shall give each person using the facility a written copy of the warning required under subsection (h) of Section 20 of this Act prior to each person's use of the facility. The operator shall post signs warning consumers of the potential effects of radiation on persons taking medication and the relationship of radiation to skin cancer.
- (g) The operator shall be responsible for proper sanitizing procedures for all sunlamp equipment and

2	(2) A tanning facility may not permit any person less than
3	18 years of age, regardless of whether the person has the
4	permission of a parent or guardian, to use tanning equipment or
5	a device defined as equipment that emits ultraviolet (UV)
6	radiation used for tanning of the skin, such as a sunlamp,
7	tanning booth, or tanning bed that emits electromagnetic
8	radiation with wavelengths in the air between 200 and 400
9	nanometers. For the purposes of this Section, "tanning
10	equipment" includes any accompanying equipment, such as
11	protective eyewear, timers, and handrails. "Tanning equipment"
12	does not include any of the following:
13	(a) Phototherapy devices utilized by appropriate
14	health care professionals under the direct supervision of a
15	physician who is trained in the use of phototherapy
16	devices.
17	(b) Devices used for personal use in a private
18	residence.
19	(c) Devices intended for purposes other than the
20	irradiation of human skin.
21	(d) Devices used to apply chemicals to the skin to
22	achieve a bronze color, commonly referred to as spray-on,
23	mist-on, or sunless tans.
