The sum of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof 1 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Institutions Regulatory Fund to the Department of Financial 3 and Professional Regulation for the ordinary and contingent 4 5 expenses of the Department of Financial and Professional 6 Regulation and the Division of Banking, or their successors, in administering and enforcing the Illinois Savings and Loan 7 Act of 1985, the Savings Bank Act, and other laws, rules, and 8 9 regulations as may apply to the administration 10 enforcement of the foregoing laws, rules, and regulations, as amended from time to time. 11
- Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2013.
