A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the
8 Student Loan Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent
9 expenses:

5 Section 5. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
8 for costs associated with Federal Loan System Development and
9 Maintenance.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
12 Assistance Commission from the Student Loan Operating Fund
13 for distribution as necessary for the following: for payment
14 of collection agency fees associated with collection
15 activities for Federal Family Education Loans, for Default
16 Aversion Fee reversals, and for distributions as necessary
17 and provided for under the Federal Higher Education Act.

18 Section 15. The following named amount, or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal
20 Congressional Teacher Scholarship Program Fund to the
21 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
22 purpose:

1 For transferring repayment funds collected
 2 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship
 3 Program to the U.S. Treasury400,000

4 Section 20. The sum of \$290,000,000, or so much thereof
 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 6 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
 7 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for
 8 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection
 9 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under
 10 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for
 11 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default
 12 Aversion Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for
 13 other distributions as necessary and provided for under the
 14 Federal Higher Education Act.

15 Section 25. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
 16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
 17 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 18 Commission for payment of grants for the Federal College
 19 Access Challenge Grant Program, with up to six percent of the
 20 funding appropriated to meet allowable administrative costs,
 21 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act (CCRAA),
 22 as provided by law.

1 Section 30. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
3 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
4 Commission for the John R. Justice Student Loan Repayment
5 Program.

6 Section 35. The sum of \$371,309,400, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
8 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant
9 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program,
10 as provided by law, and for administrative costs not to
11 exceed two percent of the total appropriation in this
12 section.

13 Section 40. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
15 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for costs
16 associated with marketing for the College Illinois! Prepaid
17 Tuition Program.

18 Section 45. The following named amount, or so much
19 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
20 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
21 for the following purpose:

2 Section 50. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
4 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
5 for costs associated with the Veterans' Home Nurses' Loan
6 Repayment Program pursuant to Public Act 95-0576.

7 Section 55. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
9 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
10 for grants to eligible nurse educators to use for payment of
11 their educational loan pursuant to Public Act 94-1020.

12 Section 60. The following named amounts, or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
14 from the Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student
15 Assistance Commission for the following purposes:

16 Grants and Scholarships

17 For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships2,500,000

18 For the payment of scholarships to students
19 who are children of policemen or firemen
20 killed in the line of duty, or who are
21 dependents of correctional officers killed
22 or permanently disabled in the line of

1 duty, as provided by law1,100,000
 2 For payment of Illinois Scholars Scholarships40,000
 3 Total \$3,640,000

4 Section 65. The following named amount, or so much
 5 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 6 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 7 Commission for the following purpose:

8 Grants and Scholarships

9 For the Golden Apple Scholars of
 10 Illinois program, as provided by law4,900,000

11 Section 70. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 13 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 14 for the Loan Repayment for Teachers Program.

15 Section 75. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Accounts
 17 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 18 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent
 19 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
 20 Act of 1986.

21 Section 80. The sum of \$90,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
 2 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
 3 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
 4 Program, as provided by law.

5 Section 85. The following named amount, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 7 Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 8 Commission for the following purpose:

9 To support outreach, research, and
 10 training activities10,000,000

11 Section 90. The following named amount, or so much
 12 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 13 Optometric Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the
 14 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
 15 purpose:

16 Grants and Scholarships
 17 For payment of scholarships for the
 18 Optometric Education Scholarship
 19 Program, as provided by law50,000

20 Section 95. The following named amount, or so much
 21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 22 Illinois National Guard and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the

1 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
2 purpose:

3 Grants and Scholarships

4 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
5 Naval Militia Scholarships
6 at State-controlled universities
7 and public community colleges in
8 Illinois to students eligible to
9 receive such awards, as provided by law20,000

10 Section 100. The following named amount, or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
12 Illinois Future Teacher Corps Scholarship Fund to the
13 Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
14 purpose:

15 Grants and Scholarships

16 For the Golden Apple Scholars of
17 Illinois Program, as provided by law140,000

18 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
19 2013.
