SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

605 ILCS 5/7-202from Ch. 121, par. 7-202605 ILCS 5/7-202.23 new

Amends the Illinois Highway Code. Provides that motor fuel tax funds allotted to municipalities may be used for the treatment or removal of trees infected with Dutch elm disease or ash trees infected with the emerald ash borer from any parcel of public or private property within the municipality.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by changing
Section 7-202 and by adding Section 7-202.23 as follows:

Sec. 7-202. Motor fuel tax funds allotted to the several
municipalities shall be used for one or more of the purposes
stated in Sections 7-202.1 through <u>7-202.23</u> 7-202.22.

11 (605 ILCS 5/7-202.23 new) Sec. 7-202.23. Treatment or removal of elm trees infected 12 13 with Dutch elm disease or ash trees infected with the emerald ash borer (Agrilus planipennis Fairmaire) from any parcel of 14 15 public or private property within the municipality. Moneys used 16 for the treatment or removal of trees on private property under 17 this Section are eligible for reimbursement under Section 18 11-20-12 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
